The ALWAYS Mission Statement

The ALWAYS mission is to open the doors to justice for Arizona's vulnerable young people and human trafficking survivors. We achieve this by providing no-cost legal services and advocacy for our clients, who, historically, are unable to access legal help. With help from ALWAYS, they can receive the justice they deserve. Working through referrals from our social service partners, we help clients address legal barriers that stand in the way of safety, stability, and self-sufficiency.

Who does ALWAYS serve?

Individuals 24 years old and younger who have been impacted by:

- Abuse
- Homelessness
- Foster Care

Trafficking survivors of all ages.

Who are ALWAYS's clients?

Last year's numbers:

- 70% are women and girls
- 76% identify as victims of crimes
- 29% have experienced foster care
- 17% have experienced trafficking

What can ALWAYS do to help?

- Assist with family law matters;
- Assist with affirmative immigration applications;
- Assist with criminal history repair.
- Other related issues.
